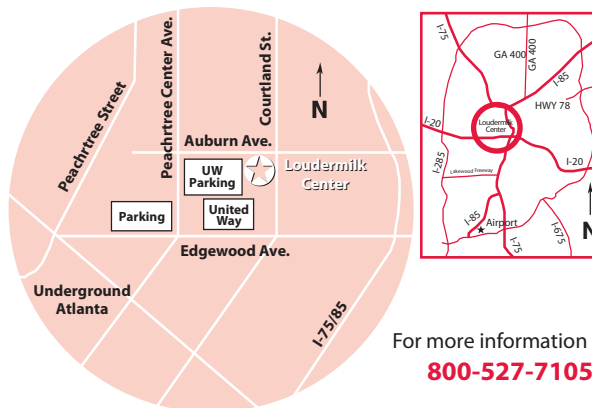
Directions from Hartsfield International Airport
